National Funding Scheme comes to Cambridge

The National Funding Scheme is delighted to support all organisations in Cambridge and the surrounding area with their fundraising activities and this week had the pleasure of meeting some of the city's charitable organisations. The occasion was generously hosted by e-Luminate Foundation, an Ambassador of the National Funding Scheme.

The <u>National Funding Scheme (NFS</u>) is a registered charity set up to support charitable organisations raise much needed funds through the DONATE platform. As DONATE is a multi-channel platform individuals can make immediate donations using their mobile device via SMS text, web app, QR codes, Near-Field Communication. Soon DONATE will also provide a route to donate via ApplePay. In addition, NFS provides additional services such as case studies, statistical reports, technology updates, signage templates as well as offline support all for free to help organisations raise valuable additional funding. DONATE can also be used during special events such as dinners, galas, receptions and even silent auctions. To date 350 organisations have registered with the National Funding Scheme across the UK, ranging from large to small scale. This week the National Funding Scheme met with a handful of local organisations including Cambridge Science Centre who commentated on the potential of adopting DONATE.
